The situation in the occupied territories of Azerbaijan

Letter dated 20 June 2018 from the Permanent Representative of Azerbaijan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to convey herewith the records of violations of the ceasefire by the Republic of Armenia in May 2018 (see annex).*

During the reporting period, the armed forces of Armenia violated the ceasefire regime 2,883 times and continued to use large-calibre guns and heavy weaponry from their positions in the occupied territories of the Republic of Azerbaijan and from the territory of the Republic of Armenia.

The military occupation by the armed forces of Armenia of the territories of Azerbaijan is the result of the explicitly annexationist agenda of Armenia and the major obstacle to achieving peace, security, stability and socioeconomic development in the region.

The sooner Armenia withdraws its armed forces from the Nagorno-Karabakh region and other occupied territories of Azerbaijan, the earlier the conflict will be resolved and both countries and their peoples will benefit from the prospects of cooperation and economic development.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annex circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 35 and 40, and of the Security Council.
