

Letter dated 19 October 2018 from the Permanent Representative of Azerbaijan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

In its written communication for the report of the Secretary-General entitled "Necessity of ending the economic, commercial and financial embargo imposed by the United States of America against Cuba" (A/73/85), the Republic of Armenia once again made a false statement, the only purpose of which was to mislead the international community and deny its responsibility for apparent non-compliance with the Charter of the United Nations and international law.

In this connection, I would like to refer to documents A/71/627-S/2016/986 and A/71/831-S/2017/199, which contain our comprehensive response to Armenia's falsifications, and should be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 35, 41 and 43, and of the Security Council.
