## **Letter dated 19 October 2018 from the Permanent Representative of Azerbaijan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General**

In its written communication for the report of the Secretary-General entitled “Necessity of ending the economic, commercial and financial embargo imposed by the United States of America against Cuba” (A/73/85), the Republic of Armenia once again made a false statement, the only purpose of which was to mislead the international community and deny its responsibility for apparent non-compliance with the Charter of the United Nations and international law.
